**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**FESTIVAL HEADQUARTERS**

Festival Headquarters is located in the Music Resource Center, Room N235 (blue section) of the Arts and Communication Center. Basic FIRST AID is available there. With immediate, non-emergency concerns, call 920-424-4224.

**BUILDING LOCATIONS**

All events will be held in two adjacent locations on campus: Arts and Communication Center and Swart Hall (see campus map). All sites are in close proximity and are ramp accessible. NOTE: Experimental Theater is in A/C West, across the courtyard from the A/C lobby.

**INFORMATION TABLES**

Information tables are located in the main lobby of the A/C building and the first floor of Swart Hall. Complete FESTIVAL PROGRAMS and SOURVENIR T-SHIRTS will be available for purchase at the information tables. T-shirt sales support UW-Oshkosh CMENC!

**PARKING**

Buses should unload students on Woodland Avenue between Algoma Boulevard and Elmwood Street, then proceed west, two blocks to High Street, turn left on High Street and park in the Kolf Sports Center parking lot (see map). **All buses must park in the Kolf Lot.**

All campus parking lots are open and free for passenger vehicle parking during the festival. Limited street parking is also available. See the campus map.

**FESTIVAL SCHEDULE**

The Wisconsin School Music Association (WSMA) produced the schedule for this state festival. WSMA did its very best to honor thousands of time requests and avoid conflicts whenever possible. If conflicts remain, the largest group from within the same school should have priority. Please inform door monitors if delays are anticipated. Directors may make substitutions within their own school's entries in a specific room by notifying the door monitor, but it is NOT permissible to change rooms.

**RESULTS POSTING**

Unofficial results will be posted in the second floor hallway of the A/C Building (above the main lobby), and in the first floor hallway of Swart Hall. Please allow up to 60 minutes for processing. Directors may pick up completed adjudication forms after the last results for the school have been recorded at Festival Headquarters (Room N235, A/C). Envelopes not retrieved will be mailed directly to the school.
