

WSMA Middle Level State Honors Choir Audition Requirements

Eligibility

Choir students regularly enrolled as full or part-time students in grades 6, 7 and 8 from WSMA-member schools are eligible to audition for the Wisconsin Middle Level State Honors Music Project. A student must be a regularly enrolled member of their school choir during the April audition and October Honors performance.

Requirements - All eligible choir students are required to perform:

1. A Class B or Class A solo from the current WSMA Solo & Ensemble Music Festival List. Students must provide the adjudicator with an original, printed version of their solo. Students must provide their own accompanists, or use a pre-recorded accompaniment. If needed, the CD or tape player must be provided by the performer.
2. Vocalizing exercises as requested by the adjudicator.
3. Sightreading material to be presented during the audition.
4. Each participant is also required to participate in a 15-minute non-adjudicated Ensemble Class which will be scheduled within 60 minutes after the audition.
